Dear S6 families,

END OF TERM KEY INFORMATION FOR S6 STUDENTS AND FAMILIES

As the last academic term of learning comes to an end for our S6 students, I thought it may be helpful to share some key information with our S6 families about the final events planned for 6 students.

On Wednesday 1st April, we have agreed with students that we will provide cake and refreshments during lunchtime in the lower gym hall – this will give our S6 students an opportunity to sign their leavers shirts with staff. **However normal timetabled classes are compulsory that morning – no S6 should be out of class prior to lunch that day.** It is a busy day where students are preparing for very important SQA exams, so we must ensure that classes run without any disruption to learning and teaching. **We would also ask S6 not to stay in the building in the afternoon if they do not have classes as staff will be busy teaching normal timetabled classes.**

S6 Activity Day – Thursday 2nd April – Delta Force Paintball Trip

Students will travel by coach to the Paintball Trip. **Buses will leave the school sharp at 9.15am.** Students must ensure they are in the playground by 9am. We would advise that old clothes are worn that day and that students bring a pair of gloves so that they do not have to purchase a pair on site. **A packed lunch / snacks should also be brought on the trip.** If any student has signed up late directly with the paintball company, they should meet us at the site no later than 10am. **Students are likely to be dropped off around 2pm upon return.**

S6 Prom – Wednesday 3rd June – The Village Hotel, Glasgow city Council

Students should arrive between 7pm and 7.15pm for welcome mocktails. Dress code is formal / smart. We have spoken to the students and would like to highlight that no alcohol must be brought to the prom – bag searches will be undertaken by security staff at the hotel, and they may refuse entry if they find anything on our young people. Those aged 18 on the evening will be able to purchase alcohol after the meal – but photographic ID will be required, and it is strictly one drink per ID served as per the rules of the hotel.

Return of School iPads

Upon the day of the last SQA timetabled exam, every S6 students is required to hand in their school iPad and charger which were issued to students this session. Students should ensure they return their iPad charged and should reset their passcode to 10-20-30. If a student does not return their iPad prior to Prom, they may not be able to attend this event. We have a very tight turnaround to wipe the iPads in preparation for our new S1 students enrolling, so it is vital that we receive all devices within the exam period.

We are very much looking forward to both the Activity Day and the Prom – both of which are being partly subsidised by the school. It is therefore vital that our S6 leavers remain focused on learning until the official study leave begins.

We have highlighted our expectations in terms of last day celebrations, and our young people have been warned that if they fail to follow our expectations, their place at prom and the activity day will be removed, as well as the potential prospect of not being presented for SQA exams. We very much appreciate your support in reinforcing our expectations at home – the last day will be a normal working day with attendance at all classes expected, except for the Paintball trip.

Please encourage your young person to keep an eye on the school S6 Team during the exam diet as further information will be provided about Prom and Yearbook collection.

I would also like to wish all our S6 the very best of luck with their forthcoming SQA exams. It has been a pleasure working with S6 this year.
