

# Roadworks Newsletter

Welcome to this newsletter about the water mains improvement project at Edmiston Drive, which will be ongoing until October 2020.

Caledonia Water Alliance (CWA) and Scottish Water are delivering these essential works to ensure fresh, clean water continues to be delivered to customers and communities in the area.

Ibrox Primary School is working together with Scottish Water and CWA to ensure the children are safe during this time.

## How this might impact you

During the works, Edmiston Drive will be closed to through traffic. However, to assist parents and pupils at Ibrox Primary School, access will be provided for drop-off and pick-up in the morning and evening on Edmiston Drive.

One-way access will be provided to Edmiston Drive from its junction with Broamloan Road, and the exit will be via Copland Road.

There will be a designated drop-off and pick-up zone situated beside Ibrox football ground on Edmiston Drive. There will also be a marshalled pedestrian crossing for parents and pupils to access the school.

We appreciate that this work will cause delays and we thank you for your patience and understanding whilst this essential work is completed.

## Health and Safety - Keeping Your Children Safe

Understandably, some children are drawn to construction sites as exciting places to play, but they are not playgrounds and playing on them can have fatal consequences.

As the children will be curious about the site works, we have organised a visit at the beginning of term for P2 to P7. Once P1 have settled into the school we will arrange for them to visit the area too.

We're also asking parents/ guardians to help us keep children safe by warning them against playing in dangerous areas, including building sites.

We recognise that the new drop-off and pick-up guidelines is going to be inconvenient but we're asking you to please use the car park at the side of Ibrox stadium to ensure the safety of the children.



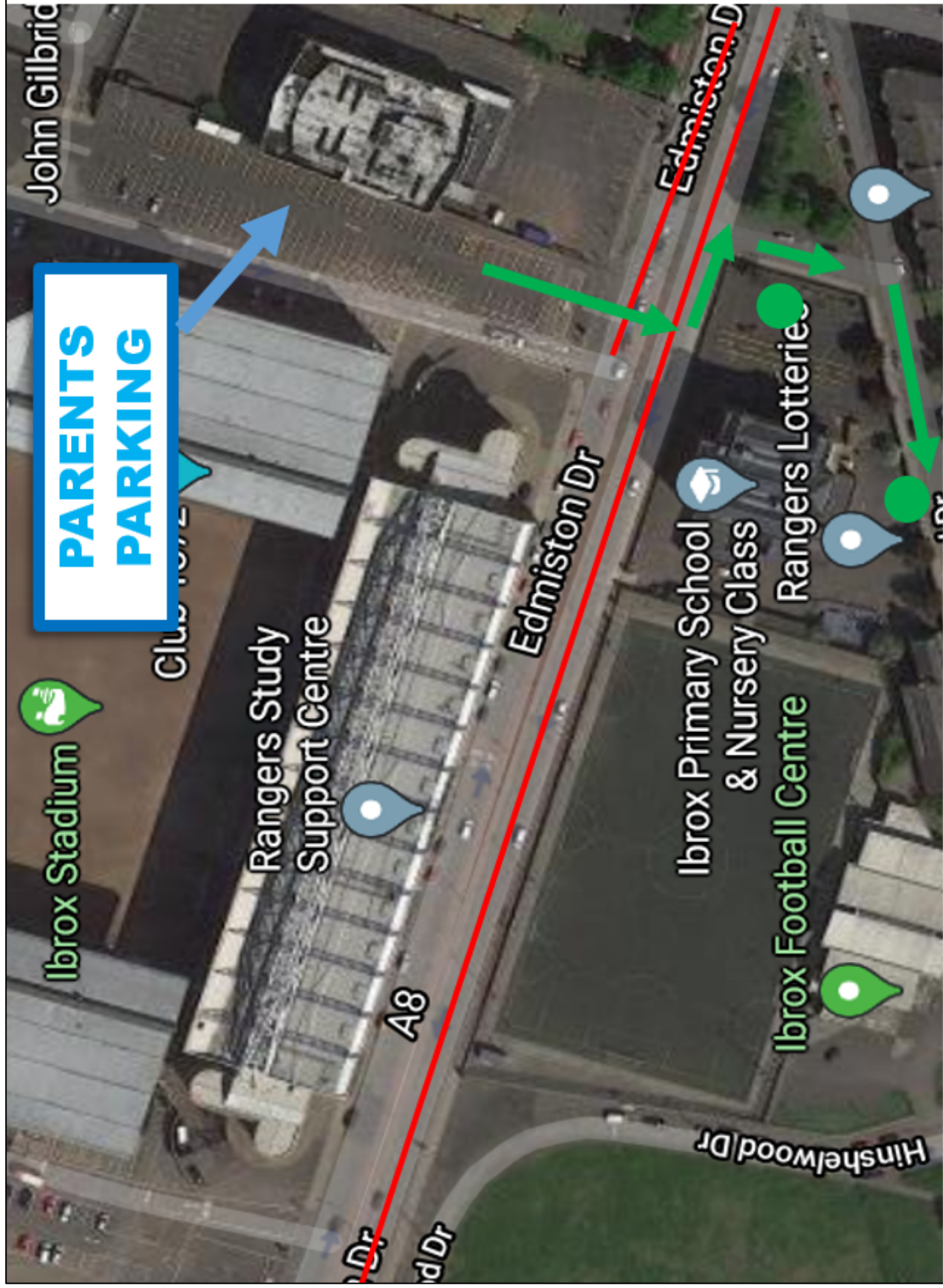
