Scottish Water On-Going Local Improvement Works

As you are aware, Scottish and Caledonia Water are undertaking major works in the local area. We have been working closely to minimise disruption, and have arranged a drop off and collection area for those families who bring the car to school. The drop off zone is the Rangers stadium car park, directly opposite the school, which can be accessed by driving round the back of Rangers stadium. This is to reduce congestion on Hinshelwood Drive and ensure the safety of our children and families. However, it has been noted that the volume of cars on Hinshelwood Drive has been increasing, causing congestion and reducing safe passage for pedestrians. Please can we ask that you use the drop off zone while the works are taking place to ensure that all our families can come to school safely. Thank you.
