from Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> February**

<p>am session 9.10am – 11.45am pm session 1.10pm – 3.55pm</p> <p>We are introducing this change to the start time as a temporary measure to minimise the number of parents at the gate at any one time.</p> <p>Staff will be in the nursery outdoor area when you drop your child off which will allow them to meet you at the gate as quickly as possible.</p>	<p>P1 -3 children and other children attending school can arrive between 8.50am-9.05am. When children arrive they should enter through their specific gate (see below) and go straight to class where their teacher will be waiting to meet them.</p> <p>At the end of the day you can collect your child between 2.50-3pm. Your child and their class will be with their teacher in the playground – P1 &amp; P1/2 – infant playground and P2/3 &amp; P3 – upper playground. Your child will be able to leave as soon as they see you.</p>	<p><b>P1 &amp; P1/2</b> – infant gate (Hinshelwood Drive) – P1 stand to right &amp; P1/2 stand to left <b>P2/3 &amp; P3</b> – upper gate (corner of Hinshelwood Place &amp; Edmiston Drive) – P2/3 stand Hinshelwood Place &amp; P3 Edmiston Drive) <b>Keyworkers &amp; class bubbles</b> – back gate (Edmiston Drive) <b>Adults must ensure they maintain a 2m distance from other adults</b></p> 	<p>P1 &amp; P1/2 will use the front door to enter and exit for breaks. P2/3 &amp; 3 will use the back door to enter and exit for breaks.</p> <p>We will continue to use “zones” in the playground to ensure children are within their class “bubble” at all times.</p> <p>We have made plans for lunchtime to ensure we keep numbers low in the dinner hall.</p> <p>Children who bring a packed lunch to school will eat this in the Family Room sitting at a table with other children from their class (bubble).</p>

**Additional key points –**

**- There will be NO BREAKFAST CLUB available.**

- If your child or anyone in the family are unwell, or are displaying any symptoms, please follow government guidance and stay at home.
- Children should all wear school uniform when attending school.
- Parents should wear masks when dropping off and collecting their children.
- Please remember to observe social distancing and to move away from the gates as quickly as possible when dropping off and collecting your children.
- Lateral Flow Testing (LFT) has been introduced for all nursery and school staff who wish to participate.
- We have a Health and Safety Group with representatives from all staff groups that meets regularly.
- We have a nursery and school risk assessment to reflect the current situation. If you would like a copy of this please contact the school office.
