



Ibrox Primary School & Nursery Class

How are we keeping everyone safe?



Drop off and pick up

- Staggered start times for school (see separate sheet for details).
9.10am/1.10pm for nursery drop off to minimise congestion at the gates.
- We ask parents / carers to bring children to nursery / school as close to the start time as possible to avoid waiting at the gate.
- Staggered finish times to avoid congestion.
- **Parents encouraged to "DROP and GO"/"PICK UP and GO" at the gate.**
- 2m distance should be kept between adults and a face covering should be worn by adults when dropping off and picking up children.
- Change of gates and doors to enter and exit to minimise contact between children.

Cleaning

- We have a day cleaner who cleans key areas throughout the day.
- The nursery is cleaned between the am and pm session by the day cleaner.
- The school is cleaned daily between 3-6pm by 3 cleaners.

Breakfast Club

- Families should inform the school if they intend to use the breakfast club.
- Children will sit in class groups to minimise contact between children.

Health and Safety Group

- All staff are represented on the group.
- Meets regularly to discuss key documents.
- Key documents are added to the school App and Blog.
- Weekly walk round the building to monitor safety measures in place.

Break and lunchtime

- There will be 2 break times and 2 lunch times to minimise contact between children.
- Classes will have their breaks within an allocated zone.
- Packed lunches will be eaten in the Family Room and lunches in the dinner hall will be staggered to reduce numbers .
- Classes will sit together at specific tables.
- Nursery children will eat lunch in the playroom.
- 4 days a week infant classes will be at the park for lunch reducing numbers in the dinner hall and children and staff in the building.
- Each class will have their own box of equipment to use.

In school

- Children and adults will wash their hands when entering the classroom and throughout the day.
- We will keep a record of which adults are working with which children throughout the day.
- Inside, adults will work with no more than 1 "bubble" per day.
- Adults will ensure they keep a 2m distance between each other.
- Face coverings will be worn by adults in communal areas. In classes people can wear face coverings if they choose.
- All school staff have the opportunity to take part in regular lateral flow testing.

How can you help...

If your child or anyone in your family feels unwell and is displaying symptoms you should stay at home, following Government guidelines.

Children should not bring personal possessions i.e. toys, books & games to school.
