All parents/carers should DROP and GO / PICK UP and GO. Children must enter and exit using the allocated gates. We are aware this is not easy for families who have more than 1 child to collect however it is important we follow this guidance to minimise transmission of the virus. Adults must ensure they maintain a 2m distance from other adults. When children arrive they should enter through their specific gate (see gate diagram) and door then go straight to class where a member of staff will be waiting to meet them. At the end of the day you can collect your child between 2.50-3pm. Your child and their class will be with their teacher in the playground – P1 & P1/2 – infant playground and P2/3 & P3 – upper playground. Your child will be able to leave as soon as they see you. Please do not arrive at school before 2.50pm and leave when you have collected your child/children.	P4-7 children can arrive at school between 8.45-9am. They should go to their allocated zone (see below). When the bell rings at 9am the children should make their way to their class. School staff will be in the playground to supervise between 8.45-9am. Children should not arrive before 8.45am unless they are attending Breakfast Club. P4-7 children will be dismissed at 3pm.

We have a nursery and school risk assessment to reflect the current situation. If you would like a copy of this please contact the school office.
