## Water bottles


The water fountain in school is still out of use. Please continue to send your child to school with a filled water bottle, particularly at the moment when the weather is so warm.

#### iPads

Digital Update

Currently all P7 children are entitled to an iPad to support learning, our new Primary 7 children have all been issued with a device to use in class and at home. Last year we were fortunate that the Scottish Government invested a lot of money into Digital Inclusion iPads and we were able to provide iPads to children out with P7, this was particularly important during school closure. Unfortunately, money can't be invested year on year and there will be no additional "DI" iPads allocated to the school. I have a small supply of returned iPads and will be wiping these and requesting new usernames for children who had a sibling in P7 last session and no longer have access to a device. The service desk is currently processing new pupil accounts and staff accounts and is very busy. I hope that by mid Sept we would have the additional devices out to families.

If your child has an iPad please ensure they bring it to school, charged, each day.

All iPads were allocated with an Apple wire and plug, if this is lost it is up to you to replace them as these are expensive items.

### Showbie, Sumdog and Glow accounts

Accounts are being moved on to reflect the classes for
this session. Your child's usernames will remain the same.
Class Teachers will use Showbie and Sumdog to support
learning and issue some homework. Glow accounts are
only required if you are wanting to join our Coffee and

# Health & Safety Reminders
