NUT FREE SCHOOL



This year we will return to our plan to award the Supertreaters at the end of the school year (June 2022). Our Term 1 Supertreaters will be announced on Thursday 7th October. We will keep you updated on this via our blog and Twitter.

School lunches are free for all children in P1-4. The cost of a school lunch for children in P5-7 who pay is £1.90. You can pay with cash or online.

Primary 5 will receive free school meals from January 2022 followed by Primary 6 & 7 in August 2022.

Moving forward it is expected that all payments will be made online via ParentPay. More details on this will be provided on this as required.



Our breakfast club is open from 8am each day. The cost is £2. For any additional children the cost is £1. Children who attend breakfast club are supervised until they go into school at 8.50am (P1, P2/1 & P2) or outside (3-7).

Attendance

We continue to encourage good attendance and time keeping however we do appreciate these are still difficult times we are living in.

If your child is unwell please keep them at home to avoid the spread of illnesses. Call the absence line (0141 471 3710 or 0141 287 0039) or the school to inform us that your child is going to be absent.

If your child is absent due to COVID (self-isolating / waiting for a test result / have COVID) please ensure the school is informed of this. There is a specific recording system for this so we can differentiate between absences but most importantly it will allow us to inform the school community if there are confirmed positive cases linked to the school.

Thank you for your on-going support with this as we continue to ensure we are keeping everyone as safe as possible.

Health & Safety Reminders

Please remember, at drop off and collection times either **drop and go or pick up and go!** Also, please try to arrive as close to the time you need to be there at to avoid an unnecessary gathering of people at the gates.

We would ask that adults at the gate wear a **face covering** and keep a **1m distance** from each other.

Ensure your child uses the gate allocated to their class.

As always, if you or any of your family feel unwell or display symptoms, please seek medical advice. It is important to keep the school informed too, if possible.

If you are waiting for a test result you should stay at home and isolate until you have the result.
