Flu Vaccinations

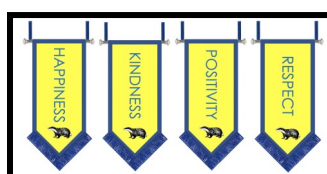
These are scheduled to take place on THURSDAY 2nd DECEMBER in the afternoon.
