Digital Update

Digital Inclusion iPads

All pupils who have a Scottish Government funded iPad should be bringing this to school each day to support learning. This is also necessary to allow the iPads to connect to the system and be registered as active by GCC.

Primary 7 iPads

P7 iPads must be returned to school on Friday 17th June. These iPads need to be wiped in order to reallocate next session which is time consuming. Please ensure iPads are in school on Friday 17th with cable and charging plug. When children start S1 they will be issued with an iPad from whatever secondary school they attend.

1-1 iPads 2022/23

As normal, next session P7 will be given a 1-1 iPad as their own personal device to use in school and at home. By Christmas next year the council intend to allocate 1-1 devices to P6 and P5 children as well. As soon as we have confirmation of dates I will let you know. If your child already has a digital inclusion device they will continue to use this as their 1-1 device.
