





Curricular Area	Details
<p><b>Language and Literacy including French in P5-P7</b></p> 	<p>Writing-Throughout term 1, P.7 will be learning about, and how to use ambitious V.C.O.P to help up-level their writing. (vocabulary, connectives, openers &amp; punctuation). Pupils will complete written tasks on paper and on their iPads. They will write a report, leaflet, informative poster, time-line and a diagram.</p> <p>Reading- pupils will learn reading strategies to improve their understanding of the texts they read. Our novel this term will be 'Time Travelling with a Hamster'. Pupils will learn to identify reliable and unreliable text sources.</p> <p>Listening &amp; Talking- pupils will be encouraged to take turns during group discussions, contribute their own idea and opinions and respect the views and opinions of their peers.</p> <p>Mrs Chalmers will continue to teach French to P.7.</p>
<p><b>Mathematics and Numeracy</b></p> 	<p>We will develop the following areas of numeracy &amp; maths:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Place value- reading and writing numbers up to and including millions</li> <li>• Addition, subtraction, division &amp; multiplication with numbers up to and including millions</li> <li>• Place value- decimals ( ordering, adding, subtracting and dividing)</li> <li>• Rounding whole numbers to the nearest 10, 100, 1000 &amp; 10,000</li> <li>• Algebra</li> <li>• Perimeter &amp; area</li> </ul>
<p><b>Interdisciplinary Learning (IDL)</b></p>	<p>Our focus will be learning about the Govan Stones and their history. We will compare life in Govan then to life in modern times.</p> <p>P.7 will work alongside P.6 and Asda to set up a food pantry in school which will be available for our families to access.</p>
<p><b>Social Studies</b></p>	<p>We will learn about Fair-trade and the impact it has on farmers involved. We will learn about the journey of certain foods from our own and. different countries to our supermarkets/ shops. Pupils will learn about their rights as children.</p>
<p><b>Sciences</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Electrical circuits</li> <li>• The human digestive system</li> <li>• Inherited and non-inherited characteristics ( genetics)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Technologies</b></p> 	<p>The apps we will focus on are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Green screen</li> <li>• Keynote</li> <li>• Book Creator</li> <li>• I-movies</li> <li>• Clips</li> <li>• Scratch</li> </ul> <p>Pupils will lean about ways to protect themselves online and how to Identify and select reliable sources on the internet.</p>
<p><b>Religious and Moral Education</b></p>	<p>Through Christianity and one other world religion( pupils' choice) they will explore the values and beliefs of these religions. Beliefs will be linked to our novel which addresses the theme of loss and death.</p>
<p><b>Health and Wellbeing</b></p> 	<p>P.E – P.7 have chosen to develop their skills in basketball this term. Our P.E day will be a Tuesday. Please ensure that your child does not wear jewellery on this day. Pupils can come to school dressed in their P.E kit.</p> <p>Personal/social- pupils will work on the 'Developing the Young Workforce' programme. They will learn about pathways they can follow after leaving school. E.g college, university &amp; apprenticeships.</p> <p>Pupils will develop basic first aid skills.</p> <p>Food &amp; Health- linked with our Fair-trade topic</p>
<p><b>Expressive Arts</b></p>	<p>Our focus for term 1 will be art. P.7 will develop skills in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Photography</li> <li>• Recreating the style of Famous artists by studying line to create shape, perspective and use of colour</li> <li>• Digital self-portraits</li> </ul>
