



Curricular Area	Details
<p data-bbox="86 120 363 190">Language and Literacy</p> 	<p data-bbox="379 120 1508 219"><u>Spelling:</u> P1 will continue with weekly spelling. Children will be learning through rhyme and moving on to consonant blends, some learning through two letter sounds(digraphs.) We will have three tricky words to practice every week.</p> <p data-bbox="379 221 1508 320"><u>Reading:</u> We continue to read the Oxford Reading Tree books this term. The children will use these to build up their ability to recognise words by sight, and they develop their skills in making predictions and answering comprehension question. The ORT books will be heard daily in class. This term we will also explore Non-Fiction texts. We will focus on texts about - Life cycles, plants and seasons.</p> <p data-bbox="379 322 1508 421"><u>Writing:</u> This term we will be developing our skills in non-fiction writing, where we will be comparing the different structures of fiction & non-fiction books. We will then use this information to write instructions and produce labelled diagrams. We will also continue with our Recount writing to develop our independent writing skills.</p> <p data-bbox="379 423 1508 521"><u>Talking and Listening:</u> This term, the children will be given opportunities to prepare and present talks about books we have been reading as well as Show 'n' Tell. We will focus on content, body language and voice.</p> <p data-bbox="379 524 1508 750"><u>Phonics:</u> This term we shall be revising single sounds and introducing two letter sounds called digraphs. We will be reinforcing these sounds through a variety of playful activities to help your child hear, say, read and write each letter. We will continue to focus on the skill of blending these letters together to read & write words.</p>
<p data-bbox="86 757 363 826">Mathematics and Numeracy</p> 	<p data-bbox="379 757 1508 958">This term gives us lots of opportunities to consolidate our numeracy understanding and skills. We will continue to subitize numbers and add and subtract. We will be learning to skip count in 2s, 5s and 10s. In maths, the children will be revisiting money and time. We will be doing some data handling as well.</p>
<p data-bbox="86 965 363 1039">Interdisciplinary Learning (IDL)</p>	<p data-bbox="379 965 1508 1039">Our IDL focus this term will be 'Lifecycles'. This will link our learning in Literacy, Science and Health and Wellbeing.</p>
<p data-bbox="86 1046 363 1144">Social Studies</p>	<p data-bbox="379 1046 1508 1144">This term we will be looking at people who can help us within our community and talking about their roles. We will be learning about the job of a shop keeper in our toy shops and that of a nursery worker in our baby daycare centre.</p>
<p data-bbox="86 1151 363 1352">Sciences</p>	<p data-bbox="379 1151 1508 1310">Our science topic this term will be biodiversity: how to grow a plant and the lifecycles of butterflies and frogs. We will have a 'butterfly garden' in class to observe the process from larvae to butterfly and we will visit the pond at the allotment to observe the tadpoles. We will be learning about life cycles up close! We will also be learning about plants and how to take care of them.</p> <p data-bbox="379 1312 1508 1352">We also have a toy shop this term and we will be learning about forces and what makes toys move.</p>
<p data-bbox="86 1359 363 1435">Technologies</p> 	<p data-bbox="379 1359 1508 1435">We will continue to use our Ipad to explore the use of a search engine, using key words to research our topic.</p>
<p data-bbox="86 1442 363 1518">Religious and Moral Education</p>	<p data-bbox="379 1442 1508 1518">This term we will be learning about how different religions celebrate significant events. We shall be finding out about Eid. We will also link our cooking sessions to festivals and celebrations</p>
<p data-bbox="86 1525 363 1682">Health and Wellbeing</p> 	<p data-bbox="379 1525 1508 1585"><u>P.E.</u> We will be learning football skills (passing and receiving, dribbling, shooting) as well as athletics in preparation for sports day.</p> <p data-bbox="379 1588 1508 1682"><u>H.W.B-</u> This term we will be exploring our bodies, friendships, privacy, how to look after plants and how to look after a baby through our RSHP topic (Relationships, Sexual Health and Parenthood).</p>
<p data-bbox="86 1688 363 1823">Expressive Arts</p>	<p data-bbox="379 1688 1508 1749"><u>Drama</u> We will continue to develop 'Helicopter stories,' in which children will write their own stories and think about how to act them out in front of an audience.</p> <p data-bbox="379 1751 1508 1823"><u>Art:</u> We will be focusing on designing, planning and making. and looking at the work of Van Gogh and discussing how his pictures make us feel.</p>
