



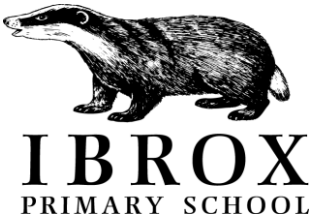


Curricular Area	Details
<p>Language and Literacy</p> 	<p>Reading: We will be exploring both fiction and non-fiction texts this term, with a focus on questions to show our understanding. We will also continue with our fortnightly 'Star Stories', as well as our ORT and Big Cat books.</p> <p>Writing: This term we will focus on Recount and Explanation writing. All children will have weekly phonics lessons, focussing on blending, patterns and decoding unfamiliar words. Primary 1 will focus on the foundations of writing, with the aim to writing more independently. Primary 2 will focus on tenses, verbs and 'adventurous' punctuation.</p> <p>Talking and Listening: We will continue to develop our T&L skills through a variety of phonological awareness tasks focussing on rhyme, syllables, and sounds. Children will also be encouraged to present a short talk on their favourite book.</p>
<p>Mathematics and Numeracy</p> 	<p>This term our maths will focus on:- money, data analysis, transformation and probability (P2). We will continue to practise place value, addition, subtraction and division through these topics. We will also continue with our number of the day, focussing on numbers before and after, odd and even numbers, rounding and skip counting. In addition, we will practise mental maths skills using: flashcards, games, songs and Glasgow Counts strategies.</p>
<p>Interdisciplinary Learning (IDL)</p>	<p>Our IDL focus this term will be 'Lifecycles'. This will connect our learning in Reading and Writing, as well as Health and Well-being and Science.</p>
<p>Social Studies</p>	<p>This term we will explore 'Our Local Area'. We will look at landscapes, transport, local organisations and places of interest in Glasgow and the surrounding areas.</p>
<p>Sciences</p>	<p>Our science this term will focus on exploring biodiversity: how to grow a plant and the lifecycles of butterflies and frogs. We will have a 'butterfly garden' in class to observe the process from larvae to butterfly and we will visit the pond at the allotment to observe the tadpoles. We will also be planting marigolds and green beans to understand what a plant needs to grow.</p>
<p>Technologies</p> 	<p>We will use our iPads this term to help us develop our research skills. The aim will be to use key words in a search engine to find relevant information related to our learning.</p>
<p>Religious and Moral Education</p>	<p>This term we will focus on religious festivals throughout April- June e.g. Ramadan and Eid. We will also continue to explore different cultures and languages.</p>
<p>Health and Wellbeing</p> 	<p>P.E- During our PE sessions, we will focus on badminton and rounders. The key skills we will work on will be: grip, serve and footwork. We all also continue to develop our team working skills.</p> <p>H.W.B- This term we will be exploring our bodies, friendships, privacy, how to look after plants and how to look after a baby through our RSHP topic (Relationships, Sexual Health and Parenthood). Further information will be sent out regarding this.</p>
<p>Expressive Arts</p>	<p>Throughout the term we will focus on developing our art skills. We will use our science learning about plants to develop skills in using line, shape, colour and tone to create interesting artwork. We will also explore design and the use of various materials through our woodwork area and our star stories.</p>
<p>How you can help/Other Information</p>	<p>Remember no jewellery, including earrings or football tops/shorts on PE days; this is Council policy. Each week we choose a 'Focus Child' in class. When you receive your letter please comment and email/tweet photographs of recent family activities. This gives your child the opportunity to present and share to the class.</p>
