<p data-bbox="86 120 363 188"><b>Language and Literacy</b></p> 	<p data-bbox="379 120 1501 176"><u>Spelling</u>: Pupils will continue to learn new sounds, words and spelling rules on a weekly basis. Pupils will be tested on these on a Friday.</p> <p data-bbox="379 176 1501 322"><u>Reading</u>: We will continue to develop our before, during and after reading skills through our class novel 'The Boy at the Back of the Class'. Pupils will respond to literal, inferential and evaluative questions. In addition, pupils will make links with characters and discuss the authors use of language, structures and setting. We will continue to make use of our core reading books.</p> <p data-bbox="379 322 1501 412"><u>Writing</u>: This term we will be creating our own persuasive writing in the form of a letter, sales pitch and poster. As well as this we will carry out some fictional writing focusing particularly on character and setting using some familiar children's stories.</p> <p data-bbox="379 412 1501 501"><u>Listening &amp; Talking</u>: Pupils will develop their confidence in talking and listening by preparing a sales pitch as part of their enterprise topic. Pupils will also participate and listen to different poems and stories for thinking which helps to generate dialogue amongst pupils.</p> <p data-bbox="379 501 1501 528"><u>French</u>: Mrs McLean will continue to take Primary 5/4 for French on a Wednesday afternoon.</p>
<p data-bbox="86 535 363 602"><b>Mathematics and Numeracy</b></p> 	<p data-bbox="379 535 1501 734">In Numeracy we will be learning to carry out multiplying and dividing two- and three-digit numbers by 10 and 100. Counting games, flashcards and maths games will be used daily in lessons to develop our mental maths agility. In Maths we will explore money where pupils will state combinations of coins and notes to pay and give change for goods. In time lessons pupils will read 12-hour times, tell the time in 5-minute intervals and use and apply knowledge of the calendar to work out durations and plan events. Weekly mental maths will take place on Friday's.</p>
<p data-bbox="86 741 363 808"><b>Interdisciplinary Learning (IDL)</b></p>	<p data-bbox="379 741 1501 824">This term our class topic will take place in form of an enterprise topic. Through this topic we will be covering various aspects of the curriculum including Literacy, Numeracy, Expressive Arts and Social Studies.</p>
<p data-bbox="86 831 363 864"><b>Social Studies</b></p>	<p data-bbox="379 831 1501 913">As part of the enterprise topic pupils will experience the different jobs involved in running a business and understand the role each one plays in its success. Pupils will learn about both profit and loss through the running of a pupil led business selling lanyards.</p>
<p data-bbox="86 920 363 954"><b>Sciences</b></p>	<p data-bbox="379 920 1501 1066">In Science this term we will be investigating electricity. Pupils will understand that electricity is a form of energy used to make things work, such as creating light, heat, sound and movement. Pupils will learn that that the flow of electricity is called a current and it travels around circuits and will have the opportunity to make some of their own. To enhance pupils understanding we will be visiting the science labs at Glasgow University.</p>
<p data-bbox="86 1072 363 1106"><b>Technologies</b></p> 	<p data-bbox="379 1072 1501 1155">We will make use of the Book Creator app this term to re-tell a familiar story. Pupils will learn about the importance of staying safe whilst being online. In addition to this, pupils will continue to make use of the Sumdog and Showbie apps.</p>
<p data-bbox="86 1162 363 1229"><b>Religious and Moral Education</b></p>	<p data-bbox="379 1162 1501 1245">In RME we will focus on Bible Stories; By learning about these stories this will allow pupils to describe some beliefs Christians have about God and Jesus. To enhance pupils understanding we will be visiting Ibrox Parish Church and meeting with the minister.</p>
<p data-bbox="86 1252 363 1319"><b>Health and Wellbeing</b></p> 	<p data-bbox="379 1252 1501 1341"><u>PE</u>: Pupils will carry out team games this term in PE. By participating in team games this will develop pupils' skills in problem solving, teamwork, leadership, fitness, agility, balance and coordination. We will also prepare for our annual Sports Day in June.</p> <p data-bbox="379 1341 1501 1406"><u>HWB</u>: Pupils this term will participate in RHSP lessons during our Health Week. These lessons will focus on being safe and happy online, how human life begins and pregnancy and birth.</p>
<p data-bbox="86 1413 363 1447"><b>Expressive Arts</b></p>	<p data-bbox="379 1413 1501 1559">This term we will be carrying out some drama-based activities related to our RME and story writing lessons. Pupils will have the opportunity to creates a short drama, from a given stimulus, and work collaboratively. As well as this, pupils will share their views and listen appropriately to the views of others about what works well and what could be improved in their own and others' work, using some drama vocabulary.</p>
