<p>Interdisciplinary Learning (IDL)</p>	<p>We attended a week long programme with Into University where we discussed, researched and built our understanding of 'Human Rights'. Through this we were given the opportunity to travel around Glasgow and visit the People's Palace and the University of Glasgow, building our sense of community and the wider world.</p>

<p>Sciences</p>	<p>Our fantastic Pharmacology student will be covering lessons linked to our body, the heart and modern medicine. Furthermore, we will work with P7, taking part in STEM challenges to build teamwork, problem solving and engineering skills.
