



## Troubleshooting

The most common iPad fault is when children dismiss the proxy box. When this pops up the must enter their AD Username and password- this is on a small label inside their iPad. If safari is not connecting they have probably dismissed the proxy box which will stop the internet working. Follow the steps to the right to troubleshoot. Please report any other faults to class teachers/ Mrs Chalmers.

## iPads

All children in P5-P7 are entitled to a 1-1 iPad. Children in P7 and P6 currently have these allocated, user agreements have been signed and these are going home. PLEASE ENSURE YOUR CHILD BRINGS THEIR IPAD TO SCHOOL CHARGED AND READY TO USE EACH DAY.

P5 iPADS will be allocated over the next few weeks. Children in P6/5 will take their iPads home and children in P5 will store them in school, until at least Term 3.

Please ensure you read and discuss the user agreement with your child when it comes home.

Children in P1-P4 will work to develop their digital skills using our set of 30 Shared iPads. In addition our play based classrooms have 4 iPads which are used daily to support learning.

All children in P3-P7 have a Sumdog account. Class teachers set challenges on Sumdog to allow children to consolidate Numeracy and Maths skills from class. If your child is unsure of their Sumdog login and password their class teacher can give them a copy of this. Our P2 children will be introduced to Sumdog as the year goes on. Sumdog can be accessed from any tablet device and also mobile phones. If you have any questions regarding Sumdog please ask the class teacher at Meet the Teacher on Wednesday.

This decision was made when we looked at data on level of access across the school and from pupil, staff and parent feedback. All children in P5-P7 will be moved into their new class groups online and will be issued with their username and password by the end of Term 1. The nursery will not be continuing their Showbie subscription his session.
