The children will be developing their social skills, self-esteem and self-confidence through a variety of activities. These activities include:

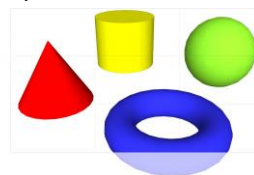
- Circle time
