Blairvadach FAQ



What happens on Monday morning?

Children will come into school at 9am as normal. Cases can be left on the stage and children will go to the Family Room to register with Mrs Armstrong and Miss Gordon. The bus will depart around 10am (as we are the second pick up school.) Parents are welcome to wait outside to wave the bus off if they wish but children will be with teaching staff who are going to Blairvadach between 9 and 10am.

How will I know my child has got to Blairvadach?

When the children arrive the Mrs A and Miss G will tweet from their accounts. Throughout the week staff from Ibrox and Blairvadach will tweet photos. They can be found by searching the #

Can I contact my child?

Blairvadach has a strict no mobile policy. CHILDREN MUST NOT BRING A MOBILE DEVICE. Children are also unable to call home as there can be up to 60 children each week in the centre and the phone calls would take away from time staff have to do activities.

Teachers will tweet at night to confirm children are settled and in the morning to say they are all up and ready to go. The staff and children are busy and having so much fun the week will pass quickly for them.

If we have any concerns about your child we have your number and will call you.

Can children bring snacks?

All meals and snacks throughout the day are provided, there is always choice and plenty of food. Children should bring a refillable water bottle if they can. Blairvadach do not allow snacks in the rooms so there is no need to send excessive snacks.

When will my child return?

Children will have a morning activity on Thursday then lunch in the centre. The bus will depart around 1:30pm so traffic and departure dependent children should return to Ibrox by 3pm. Miss Gordon and Mrs Armstrong will update on Twitter an ETA.
