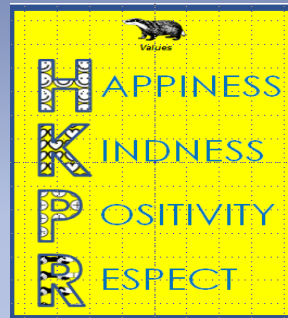

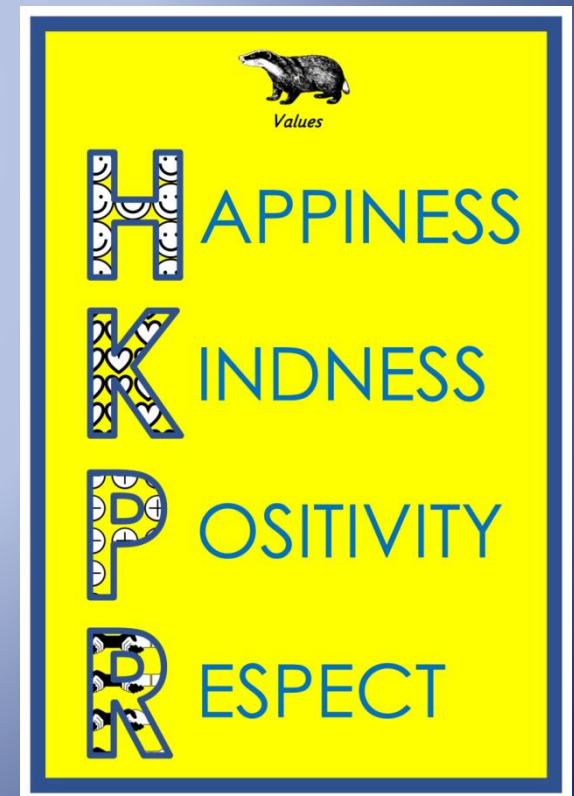

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Happiness

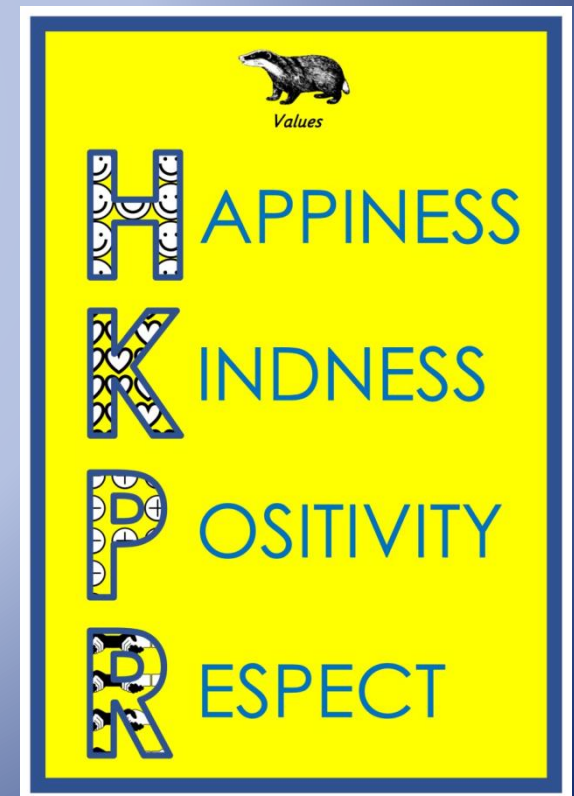
- Being grateful and having good manners

Kindness

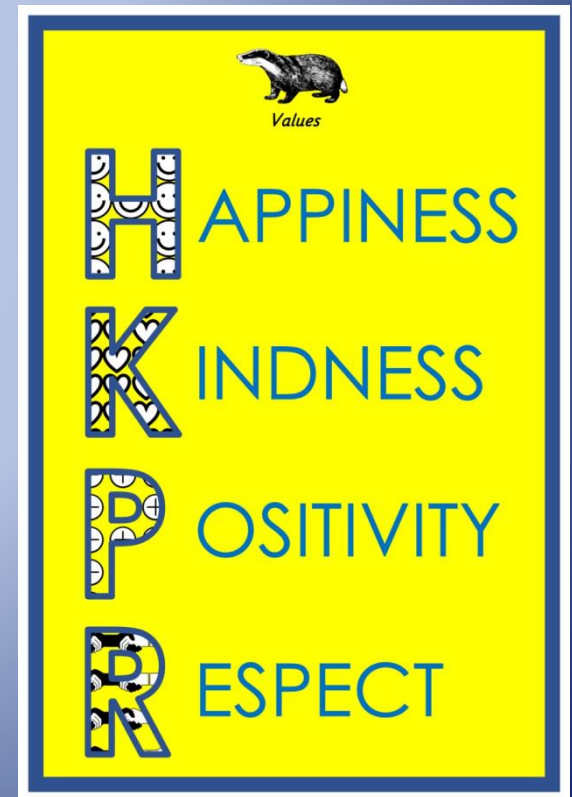
- We help each other if we are hurt

Positivity

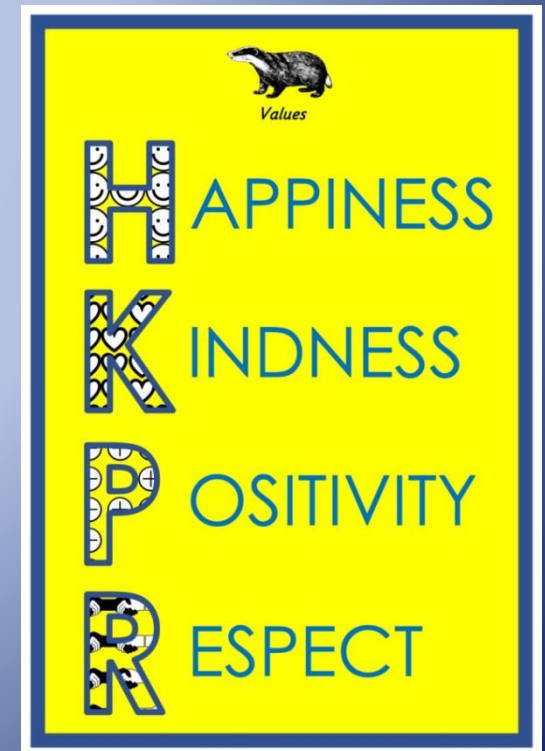
- If you think you don't like something.....try it!
