We celebrated our first ever Eid party as a school. It was a huge success with many members of our community in attendance.

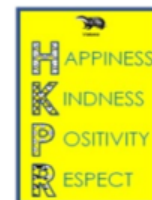

* Levels - Early = Nursery & P1 / First = P2-P4 / Second = P5- P7

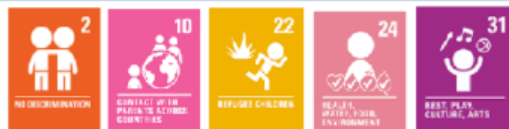
