Playground

Please remember, adults should not be in the playground before or after school unless looking to speak to a member of management or to go to the office.

NUT FREE SCHOOL

Can I please remind all families that we are a nut free school. Please **DO NOT send your child to school with any foods containing nuts. We really appreciate your support with this matter as it will ensure our children with allergies are kept safe.**

Scooters / Bikes

We kindly ask that children do not scoot or cycle in the playground at the start and end of the day. We want to try and avoid any collisions or falls.

Security - Gates

We have reviewed the entrances/exits around the school and updated when these are accessible. The gate on Hinshelwood Place will be locked at 9.15am and opened at 2.45pm. The gate on Hinshelwood Drive will be locked at 9.45am and remain locked until 2.45pm apart from when nursery children are arriving and leaving. The "big" gate on Edmiston Drive will remain unlocked however it will be shut with a chain around it.

We felt it was important to review this as Mr Gemmell (janitor) is on holiday for the next 2 weeks so he will not be in his office to help monitor who is entering and exiting the school and nursery.

School Security/Fire Safety
