Literacy



Children in both P1 and P2 will be working from the Read, Write Inc scheme. As we move through this term books will begin to come home, and online content will be available to reinforce learning.

For reading, your child will be using the Oxford Reading Tree books to practise their reading and comprehension.

For writing this term, your child will be learning about recount texts. They will be encouraged to reflect on real events and retell the story in a simple format.

Children will be encouraged to read for pleasure and may bring books home from the class/school library. Please encourage your child to read at home with you or independently to develop their reading skills. You can talk to your child about their book.

Numeracy and Maths



This term, your child will be reinforcing their knowledge and understanding of number focusing on number formation, counting, subitising and simple addition and subtraction.

In Maths, your child will be learning how to identify 2D and 3D shapes.

Please encourage your child to practise (times tables/mental strategies for number) at home – this can be done through their Magma Maths login.

Inter-Disciplinary Learning (IDL/Topic)



This term our IDL focus is 'Journeys we make' which is our topic relating to the local area. Learners will explore the local area and use this learning to support with writing, art, science and other activities.

Health and Wellbeing



Our PE days are: Monday and Tuesday. Please make sure your child has suitable shoes and comfortable P.E. kit. We will be focusing on relay races and ball skills.

Your child will continue developing their mental, social and emotional wellbeing using the colour monster. They will be developing their understanding of the different emotions we feel and actions we can take to promote good decisions. We will be discussing how we can be good friends to others and relate this learning to the school values.

Uniform and Jackets: At Ibrox Primary, we strongly encourage the wearing of uniform, this allows children to feel part of the school community and contributes positively to the school ethos and school security. The school uniform is, white/pale/navy blue shirt/polo with or without school logo, navy sweatshirt and navy trousers/skirt.
