#### Literacy


Children in P3/2 are working on the Read, Write Inc scheme. As we move through this term books will begin to come home, and online content will be available to reinforce learning.

For reading, your child will practice using the Before, During, and After Reading Strategies through focused questioning during class read-aloud sessions. Children will continue to develop their knowledge of sounds and common words.

A love of reading will be nurtured through a varied and inviting class library with comfortable spots to read throughout the classroom. Children will be encouraged to read for pleasure and may bring books home from the class/school library. Please encourage your child to read at home with you or independently to develop their reading skills.

For writing this term, we will be focusing on recount and fiction writing. Your child will focus on key tools for writing, such as punctuation, openers, and conjunctions.

## Numeracy and Maths



In Maths, we will explore patterns as well as 2D and 3D shapes. We will continue to build our knowledge of time through daily discussion.

Please encourage your child to practise their numbers at home – this can be done through their Magma Maths login.

### Inter-Disciplinary Learning (IDL/Topic)
