### P5-P7 (Second Level) P.E Programme

Jonny Penman, who is part of the GCC PEPASS (PE, Physical Activity & School Sport) team, will be working with the P5-7 classes this term on a Friday. The main focus for this work is to assess and develop the physical literacy skills of our children. This project is a Learning Community (LC) priority so all the Second Level classes in the Bellahouston and Govan LC will be working with a PEPASS teacher at some point throughout the year. The PEPASS team are also going to work with the PE staff at Bellahouston Academy in order to ensure the consistency and progression of physical literacy skills from primary school into secondary school. I am sure the children and staff will all benefit from this initiative.

### **NUT FREE SCHOOL**

### **School Lunches**

School lunches are free for all children in P1-6. The cost of a school lunch for children in P7 who pay is £1.90. The dinner hall is "cash free" - ParentPay should be used to pay for lunch. **ParentPay should also be used to order your child's lunch.**

### **Parents for the Future Partnership**

We have been provided with an Active Travel Co-ordinator who has been organising the Bike Bus and is also working to support the health and wellbeing of our families.**
