Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back! I hope you all had a lovely holiday. It is nice to be back at school, and I look forward to working with your child throughout term 3.

In addition to several whole school newsletters each term, you will receive a newsletter each term written by your child's teacher/s which will keep you informed about the curriculum and plans for the term ahead. #### Literacy



Our class novel this term is Glitter Boy by Ian Eagleton. This novel will address themes such as prejudice, bullying, discrimination and inclusion. As a class we will improve and develop reading skills. We will focus on developing skimming and scanning skills to allow pupils to quickly identify the purpose of a text. Pupils will continue to develop skills in reading for information and reading for enjoyment. Children will be encouraged to read for pleasure and may bring books home from the class/school library. Please encourage your child to read at home with you or independently to develop their reading skills. We are continuing our daily writing with CYPIC, this is allowing the children to become confident applying the tools for writing. In CYPIC, pupils are given opportunities to write about various subjects. The CYPIC writing is timed, pupils have 15 minutes to write, this has also developed pupils focus and concentration. Our CYPIC aim will be to improve punctuation in writing. As a class we will be learning about the various genres in writing, with our focus being on poetry and discursive writing, and developing our skills, knowledge and ability to create these texts. skills.

#### Numeracy and Maths



This term, your child will be reinforcing their knowledge and understanding of number focusing on money, budgeting, profit and loss. This will be part of our enterprise to raise funds for P.7 leavers' event. Pupils will set up and run a small business, taking responsibility for fundraising. Pupils will work on the 4 operations in numeracy (addition, subtraction, multiplication & division). In Maths, your child will be learning about handling information. They will collect, organise and display information on different types of graphs. We will also continue to work on fractions and percentages.

Please encourage your child to practise (times tables/mental strategies for number) at home – this can be done through their Magma Maths login.

#### Inter-Disciplinary Learning (IDL/Topic)



This term our IDL topics will be Scotland, enterprise and political democracy. We will be developing skills in mapping, literacy, technology, numeracy, reading, talking & listening, collaborative working and creativity. Pupils will learn about Scotland's physical landscape, setting up and running a business and learning about democracy, political parties and the voting system in Scotland.

#### Health and Wellbeing



Our PE days are Monday and Friday. Please make sure your child has suitable shoes and comfortable P.E. kit. We will be focusing on developing resilience, stamina, communication and teamwork which will allow us to develop skills to play volleyball.

During term 3, P.7T will complete the P.7 sections of R.S.H.P. (relationships, sexual health & parenthood), these lessons are available for parents/carers to view online.



**Lost Property:** We have a huge amount of lost property, please speak to your child about taking care of their belongings, especially jumpers and jackets. **Please ensure all clothing is labelled with their name.** Reminder, children should bring a warm, waterproof jacket each day as they go out to play in all weathers.

**Homework:** At Ibrox Primary school, we encourage using homework as a chance for children to develop key skills such as independence in learning and time management/ organisation.

In Primary 7T all homework is added to Showbie for pupils to access on a Monday morning. homework should be completed on time and returned to school or added to Showbie when requested.

It is important that pupils complete tasks to the best of their ability. During term 3 a homework grid will also be given, this will have a variety of tasks for pupils to complete, it will be linked to our IDL topics.
