Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back! Happy New Year to you all. I can't believe we are in Term 3 already.

In addition to several whole school newsletters each term, you will receive a newsletter each term written by your child's teacher/s which will keep you informed about the curriculum and plans for the term ahead. If at any time you can help with and resources related to planned learning or trips, please contact the teacher via the school office.

Literacy



Children in P1-P5 are working on the Read, Write Inc scheme. Set 1 sounds will be revisited throughout the term to ensure your child is secure in their knowledge of these. This term, we will learn set 2 diagraphs which will support their reading and writing. For further practise, Oxford reading Tree books will be used daily to support sight reading of tricky words.

As a class we will be learning about the recount and procedural genres and developing our skills, knowledge and ability to create these. We will focus on recognition of sight words, sentence structure and the ability to use their sounds to attempt writing independently. We will also look at what is included in a recipe as we will have a go at cooking this term!

Children will be encouraged to read for pleasure and may bring books home from the class/school library. Please encourage your child to read at home with you or independently to develop their reading skills. You can talk to your child about their book.

Numeracy and Maths



This term, your child will be reinforcing their knowledge and understanding of number focusing on multiplication and division. We will continuously revise the awareness of number through counting, subitizing, place value etc.

In Maths, your child will be learning how to tell the time. We will link this with our daily routines to make connections. We will also continue with measure, and we will revisit 3D shape and patterns.

Please encourage your child to practise mental strategies for number at home.

Inter-Disciplinary Learning (IDL/Topic)



This term our IDL focus is Space (children's choice), Scottish Inventors and transport. We will explore the role of the sun and moon, linking it with time. We will also look at the modes of transport within Glasgow and the wider world. We will learn 'All About Scotland' with a focus on Scottish Inventors.

Health and Wellbeing



Our PE days are: Monday and Tuesday. Please make sure your child is wearing comfortable PE kids including suitable shoes and they are not wearing earrings or any jewellery. We will be focusing on gymnastics and dance.

Your child will continue developing their mental, social and emotional wellbeing using the Emotion Works programme alongside our Colour Monsters feelings check in. We will also focus on our values, similarities and differences.



Lost Property: We have a huge amount of lost property, please speak to your child about taking care of their belongings, especially jumpers and jackets. **Please ensure all clothing is labelled with their name.** Reminder, children should bring a warm, waterproof jacket each day as they go out to play in all weathers.

Homework: At Ibrox Primary school, we encourage using homework as a chance for children to develop key skills such as independence in learning and time management/ organisation.

In Primary 1, your child will receive a numeracy task, HWB task, Literacy tasks and reading. Homework shouldn't take longer than 15 minutes per night. If your child is finding it too difficult, please let me know.

Homework is given out on a Monday. Please return on a Friday. Reading books should stay in your child's schoolbag, as we use them everyday.
