Dear Parents/Carers,

Time for Term 2!

In addition to the whole school newsletter, you will receive a newsletter each term for your child's teacher/s which will keep you informed about the curriculum, what's going on in and out of class! Literacy



Children in P1-P4 are working on the Read, Write Inc scheme. As we move through this term books will begin to come home and online content will be available to reinforce learning.

For reading, your child will be engaging with their Oxford Reading Tree books at school and these will also be sent home for homework. (Please ensure your child brings back *their* book everyday so they can practise *their* reading at school as well).

For writing this term, our focus in P2/1 will be characterisation and setting. In addition to this Primary 2s will continue to build their tools for writing through regular inputs after RWI.

Children will be encouraged to read for pleasure and may bring books home from the class/school library. Please encourage your child to read at home with you or independently to develop their reading skills. You can talk to your child about their book.

Numeracy and Maths



This term, your child will be reinforcing their knowledge and understanding of number focusing on place value, rounding and times tables (skip counting).

In Maths, your child will be learning how to tell the time (o'clock and half past on both digital and analogue clocks). They will also learn about length (specifically the language used, and measurement using non-standard materials).

Please encourage your child to practise (times tables/mental strategies for number) at home – this can be done through their Magma Maths login.

Inter-Disciplinary Learning (IDL/Topic)



This term our IDL focus is climate action. We will be developing our understanding of why clean air is important and the role we play in keeping our environment clean and healthy.

Health and Wellbeing



Our PE days are: Monday and Wednesday. Please make sure your child has suitable shoes and comfortable P.E. kit. We will be focusing on basketball and gymnastics.

Your child will continue developing their mental, social and emotional wellbeing focusing on children's rights and looking at how we can respect other people's rights. We will also look at this through RME.



Lost Property: We have a huge amount of lost property, please speak to your child about taking care of their belongings, especially jumpers and jackets. **Please ensure all clothing is labelled with their name.** Reminder, children should bring a warm, waterproof jacket each day as they go out to play in all weathers.

Homework: At Ibrox Primary school, we encourage using homework as a chance for children to develop key skills such as independence in learning and time management/ organisation.

In Primary 2/1, learners will be given their ORT reading books to practise at home alongside a literacy task and a numeracy task. They should engage with the activities and return their homework by Friday morning.

Tasks will vary; however learners will usually be provided with opportunities to master key skills such as blending, letter formation and reading in literacy, and counting, skip counting or place value in numeracy.
