Dear Parents/Carers,

We can't quite believe that Term 1 is over and we are already a few weeks into term 2! The children all worked very hard last term and we are looking forward to the same this term. Literacy



Children in P1-P4 are working on the Read, Write Inc scheme. As we move through this term ORT books will continue to come home to support reading strategies and online content will be available to reinforce learning.

For reading, your child will be focussing on comprehension and being able to answer different types of questions.

For writing this term, your child will be learning about writing letters and instructions.

Children will be encouraged to read for pleasure and may bring books home from the class/school library. Please encourage your child to read at home with you or independently to develop their reading skills. You can talk to your child about their book.

Numeracy and Maths



This term, your child will be reinforcing their knowledge and understanding of number focusing on times tables and addition and subtraction. A sheet was sent home with some online resources which can be accessed to help support understanding and fluency of times tables.

In Maths, your child will be learning how to identify and compare 2D and 3D shapes, and to measure length, capacity, mass and area. Please encourage your child to practise their times tables at home – this can be done through their Magma Maths login.

Inter-Disciplinary Learning (IDL/Topic)



This term our IDL focuses are Clean Air and Glasgow past and present. We will be developing our research skills through looking at Clean Air and working on developing skills of collaboration. In people and the past, we will be making comparisons and evaluating how things have changed over time.

Health and Wellbeing



Our PE days are: Monday and Thursday. Please make sure your child has suitable shoes and comfortable P.E. kit. We will be focusing on badminton.

Your child will continue developing their mental, social and emotional wellbeing focusing on 'people who influence us' using the NHS Your Body Matters resource.



Lost Property: We have a huge amount of lost property, please speak to your child about taking care of their belongings, especially jumpers and jackets. **Please ensure all clothing is labelled with their name.** Reminder, children should bring a warm, waterproof jacket each day as they go out to play in all weathers.

Homework: At Ibrox Primary school, we encourage using homework as a chance for children to develop key skills such as independence in learning and time management/ organisation.

In Primary 3 homework continues as in term 1. Spelling words are issued on Monday. The words should be written 3 times and then used in a sentence. Numeracy homework this term focusses on increasing fluency of times tables and resources and links have been sent home to help reinforce this. Homework should be completed and returned each Friday so it can be marked and ready for the following Monday.
