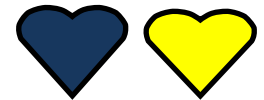
I have included some information in this newsletter about events coming up. I have also included details about summer trips as well as other information I felt was useful to share.

You can attend on Wednesday between 3.30-7.30pm to meet with your child's class teacher without an appointment. Priority will be given to those parents/carers with an appointment so it is likely you will have to wait

We hope to see lots of families on Wednesday so the teachers can update you on your child's achievements, progress and next steps learning.

## Summer Trips

I wanted to give you an overview of the costings for the Summer Trips. As you know, we always try to avoid asking families to pay a lot of money for things at school however the cost of trips is high which is why we had to ask for a contribution from families.

### P1-P4 Trip to Briarlands

2 x coaches (141 seats) = £1040

Entrance to Briarlands for 125 children @ £7.50 = £937.50

Total cost = £1977.50

Cost per child = £15.82 - £10 paid by families / £5.82 paid by school funds

### P5&P6 Trip to Safari Park

1 x coach = £500

Entrance fee to park = £455.40

Total cost = £955.40

Cost per child = £18 - £10 paid by families / £8 paid by school funds

### P7 Camping Trip

Trip = £989.36

Cost per child = £35 / school will pay for transport and food
