UNCRC

WHAT IS THE UNCRC?

The UNCRC is a legally binding treaty which recognises that children are unique and valuable human beings, and that they should be respected and protected.



The UNCRC was incorporated into Scots Law in July 2024

Our charter is above and shares on it the roles of adults as duty bearers and young people as rights bearers. The articles were voted on by young people & are the rights that mean must to our community.



On Friday 22nd November, all S1 participated in sessions that brought to life some of the UNCRC articles through active workshops. Below are some pictures of the morning:














































PUPIL VOICE

Our October Assembly was a pupil led assembly sharing updates from our captains. The captains also asked young people for their opinions and you will see below some of the priorities we will work on together this session:




UPDATES FROM DEPARTMENTS
