Please continue to respect the traffic restrictions in place outside the school at drop off and pick up times as part of Glasgow's School Streets campaign and encourage your children to walk or cycle to school. The bike shed is opened at 8am and locked at 9.10am each morning. It is opened again between 3 and 3.30pm each day. As there are times when the shed is open and unattended I recommend that your child uses a bike lock. The school cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage to property.

#### Cost of the School Day

We value opportunities to get out and about but are aware that the cost of trips can be challenging. We use the PA and school funds to subsidise all trips as much as possible. We have also recently taken advantage of public transport when possible as an affordable and interesting way to get to local events. If

you need help paying for any trips etc, please don't hesitate to get in touch. All matters are dealt with confidentially and discreetly. This includes the cost of P6 and P7 residential trips.

Your child may also be **entitled to a clothing grant and or free school meals.** Please do not hesitate to apply. All children in P1-5 receive free school meals but it is also worth applying if you are eligible as grants are often given for the school holidays. Information can be found on Glasgow City Council website. Not only will families benefit from any grants received, but the number of successful applications by families also benefits school staffing and the budget we are allocated for school.
