Phonics

We are continuing to introduce 2 new sounds a week. We have started to blend these sounds into simple CVC words (consonant-vowel-consonant, e.g. c-a-t, r-u-g).

Reading

We have been learning 'common words,' these are words which appear in many books and are often not easy to sound out, e.g. the, put, said.

We have also been sending home reading books which your child will have been looking at in class.

Writing

We are focusing on correct letter formation, writing our first names and will begin to 'have a go' at writing our own thoughts, using our phonic sounds to help us.

Talking & Listening

We are developing our talking and listening skills through discussions about stories. We will discuss our favourite parts, characters choices and making predictions about what might happen next.



As well as the weekly reading books, we are providing homework tasks through the Seesaw App.

We are posting 3 activities each Monday which we would love to see you having a go at.

Numeracy

We are continuing to count forwards and backwards, identify the number before and after. We have also been adding numbers together. We have been using objects and number lines to help us with this.

Mathematics

We have been learning about 2D shapes. We have been naming and describing their properties.

We are looking at some big events in the Autumn and Winter months; Halloween, Bonfire Night, Diwali, St Andrew's Day and Christmas. We will be learning about these events and developing our skills in art, drama, science, RME and ICT.
