Baby News

Traffic and Parking

The local community will be aware of a road traffic accident before Easter between a taxi driver and a cyclist. This happened at the junction near the school. Fortunately, there were no injuries and no one from our school community was involved. This is always a reminder that we need to take great care to ensure our children are safe. I am asking again that parents/ families **do not park** at the gates around the school. It is extremely dangerous and blocks the traffic. Can I also ask that parents/ families **do not gather** blocking exit and entry routes at **9am and 3pm**.

Each pupil will receive a City Wise booklet in which they should record any activity they complete. As a reward for participating, pupils will receive a medal at the end of the month. Healthy Eating School- Snacks and Drinks

Please support us and ensure your child does not bring a snack to school that contains nuts. Lollipops, chewing gum and multipacks are not allowed. Children can bring a water bottle to school with water or dilute juice. Energy drinks are not allowed- this includes PRIME and MONSTER drinks. We have children with medical conditions and if they were to be in contact with nuts and energy drinks, they could become seriously ill. I am sure I will have your support in keeping all our children happy and healthy.

Dinner School/Parent Pay

All Primary 1 to Primary 5 children are entitled to a free school meal. Just a reminder that you should still apply for Free Meal Entitlement and Clothing Grant in order to receive any additional payments/supports. More information can be found at https://www.glasgow.gov.uk/schoolsandlearning.

If you are entitled to a Free Meal, you can attend the breakfast club for free. Breakfast Club is available from 8.15am to 8.45am. Everyone is welcome.

Please use the pre-booking dinner school system – Parent Pay. Please contact us at the School Office – 0141 552 0010 for support. Lunches need to be ordered before 9.15am. If your child is late, they may not get their first choice of lunch. Please ensure you pre order your children's choices.
