Physical Education

Every week we have a PE specialist (David Weir) working with our children to enhance their physical education experiences. Celtic coaches have also been working with Primary 7s. We have our sports lunchtime clubs running every day. Football after school clubs run every Monday for Primary 7 and Tuesday for Primary 6. Our after-school clubs run from 3:00 to 4:00pm.

Swimming

P6 and P7 swimming blocks have started at Springburn Leisure Centre. These sessions will run throughout Term 2 and 3. Primary 6 will go a **Friday** and Primary 7 will go on a **Tuesday**.

Music Programme

We currently have 4 music instructors working with our children and staff. The children are enjoying drumming, string instruments and singing lessons. Our school choir have been busy practicing and performed at Father Thaddeus' Celebration Mass. We have also created a music room and we are practising for our Christmas Show. We are looking forward to performing for our families and local community on the 13th and 14th December.

Library Visits

All the classes have been visiting Royston Library. We will be sending home readers for all children and hope you enjoy reading for enjoyment with your child.
