Literacy & English



In Primary 2-1 we will be using the Jolly Phonics programme to learn different phonics by play, singing and games. The children will build on this by blending and creating words.

During circle time the children will be building on their talking and listening skills through singing, games and play to build their phonological awareness. The children will also be participating in 'Listen and Draw' activities.

A variety of different materials will be used to develop fine motor skills to support writing skills with the focus of everyone being able to write their first and second names.

Mathematics & Numeracy



In our Numbers base we will be learning recognition of 0-20. This will be done through play, actions, singing and outdoor learning.

The play consists of using various materials to encourage pupil choice and enjoyment.. Stations are set up in the base with tasks to be completed with playdough, sand and chalk, We will also be learning position and movement through instructions in Outdoor Learning.

Health & Wellbeing



This term we have been learning about the characters from the whole school programme of PATHS which supports the children to develop their social and emotional skills. The children really enjoy meeting Twiggles the turtle and all his friends. The lessons cover comfortable and uncomfortable feelings, sharing, taking turns and how to develop friendships,
