What is the School Improvement Plan?

Our areas for focus 2023-24 are summarised below:

Attendance

We wanted to emphasise the importance of excellent attendance at Sandaig for your child's development and success. Regular attendance allows them to fulfil their potential, learn, have fun, make new friends, experience new things in life, achieve, develop new skills, build confidence, and enhance self-esteem, ultimately giving them the best possible start in life. On the other hand, children who frequently miss school without valid reasons may become isolated from their friends, underachieve academically, and be more susceptible to engaging in antisocial behaviour. Let's work together to ensure your child's attendance remains consistent for their brighter future.

Digital Technology

Staff will be undertking specialist training on teaching of digital technology and use of Apple Applications. They will work together to develop their professional knowledge and understanding. We will be measuring the impact of this on children's motivation and engagement to learn.
