Primary 6 Curriculum Overview



Literacy & English



We are developing:

- Listening Skills
- Di and Trigraphs
- Synonyms
- Presentation skills

Speedy spelling and active spelling to increase exposure

Review a variety of text both—fiction and non fiction. This term our novel study will be Kensuke's Kingdom.

Practicing writing skills daily to practice cursive writing.

Recount Writing to allow the pupils to reconstruct a past experience in order to tell the reader what happened.

Mathematics & Numeracy



Covering the four operations:-

- Addition
- Subtraction
- Multiplication
- Division

Understanding fractions and how they are used in daily life and how these are interchangeable with percentages and decimals.

Time - practicing analogue and 24 hour clock. Being able to tell the time on both,

Daily mental math's to understand the different mathematical strategies that can be used to solve the same problem.

Health & Wellbeing



In Primary 6 we will be continuing with our Paths programme of lessons. The pupils will be engaging with the Compassionate and Connected Classrooms programme. This term we will be focusing on:

1. Emotional understanding
2. Self-control
3. Social problem solving
4. Peer relations and self-esteem

Physical Education- I need my gym kit on a Tuesday and a Thursday. (Swimming and multi-ball skills)

Pupils are developing their presentation skills and peer learning. We will be playing a variety of team games to increase teamwork.

Sciences

Interdisciplinary Learning



STEM is a joint topic we are taking part in with the primary 5 & 7's.
