In partnership with Glasgow City Council Education services, the University of Glasgow offers a week-long Taster Session aimed at school pupils across the city. Pupils will attend lectures and seminars and take part in academic support activities.

Our subject streams introduce pupils to the variety of academic areas you can study at university in Scotland. Additionally, all pupils complete our online Academic Skills module designed to prepare for the transition to Higher Education. Completion of this module will be taken into consideration upon application to the university and can form a part of an adjusted offer of entry.

Pupils can choose from four academic streams and sample a range of subjects through lectures and seminars with university teaching staff. The 2020 streams are:

- Arts & Humanities
- Physical Sciences

- Social Sciences
- Mathematical Sciences

Applications will be open until March 13th 2020

Eligibility

All current Glasgow S5 pupils who are interested in applying to university are welcome on the Taster week programme. Pupils wishing to go to university who may not be participating in other programmes, i.e. Reach, Top-up are encouraged to attend.

Completion of both the on-campus component AND the online academic module can be used by admissions for an adjusted offer of entry. To qualify for an adjusted offer, pupils should also meet the following criteria;

- Live in a priority postcode area
- Have care experience
- Are estranged from family and living without family support

You may also be considered if you are seeking asylum in the UK, have refugee status or are a carer.
