
- including PCTC contact information on the Head Teacher's letters to parents;


Are you aware that there is a Parent, Carer & Teacher Council (PCTC) for Shawlands Academy?


Do you know how to contact the PCTC?




The PCTC is keen to improve communications and be as accessible as possible. Which of the following platforms do you use?
