Pupil Leadership

We have launched our first Shawlands Pupil Voice Forum. This is led by our school captains, and is fed into by our house captains, values ambassadors and other pupil groups. The first task they are undertaking is speaking to PSE classes and gathering views about how we can communicate better throughout the school and we are also working on a new motto, which our young people are offering suggestions for.

Primary / Secondary Transition

P7 students from all our associate primaries will be visiting Shawlands Academy for 3 full days in total: 2 days in May and 1 in June.

At our Inservice day last week, English, Maths and Science staff worked with Primary colleagues to moderate work. This is an important part of the transition process and something that we are building on to help more meaningful curricular transitions.

We are also working very closely with our families in Govanhill. Two members of staff are working with Community Services in the Govanhill area once a week to build relationships with our families in Annette Street and Cuthbertson Primaries.
