#### Head Teacher Report

- EID Celebration for the first time in 4 years this week
- Still experiencing staffing issues due to COVID
- We are now able to let parents into the school with the relaxing of the rules but with some distancing requirements still in place parents will be able to attend the P7 leavers service and plans for an end of term concert
- End of term reports being worked on
- 55/60 P1 intake expected next term which means still operating with 15 classes in total
- Transition Day for the Academy 25<sup>th</sup> / 26<sup>th</sup> May for the P7
- Priorities for next year continuing with the writing work that the school has been focusing on in this 2021/2022. New resources being brought in for next term to support this continuation of learning.
- PATHs will be working with various age groups across the school (previously for enfants) designed to facilitate and promote self-regulating, development of self-control, emotional awareness and interpersonal problem-solving skills.
- PEF Funding is down from last year. Hope to re-introduce 'stay and play' next term.
- Counsellor support on a few days a week will be reinstated for next year term
- Volunteer(s) from the Parent Council required to join the interview panel due to Mrs McClounan moving on to a new chapter which means the school will be looking to replace the dept head position (Action: RD)
