## Getting It Right For Every Child (GIRFEC)

National Practice Model is the framework we use in Scotland for improving the wellbeing of children and young people. It is a shared framework used by education practitioners and external services such as health and social work to assess a child's needs and plan support through three core tools: the My World Triangle, which understands a child's world; the Wellbeing Indicators (SHANARRI), which assess progress in key areas; and the Resilience Matrix, for more complex situations. The model emphasizes a child-centred approach, involving young people and their families in decision-making and providing the support needed.

Over the past few terms, we have been providing opportunities for children to become more familiar with the concepts and language associated with My World Triangle, emphasising their rights and the alignment with Rights Respecting Schools. This has included a Weekly Focus with links to My World Triangle which has been explored in weekly assemblies and in class. Our Focus this week has been Earth Day, which fell on Wednesday 22nd April this year. Over the weekend, you could ask your child what they learned about Earth Day and how it links to My World Triangle!

Next week, the Weekly Focus will be each class discussing and planning their Learning Journey for the term ahead. The context for learning this term will be the Commonwealth Games and World Cup.
