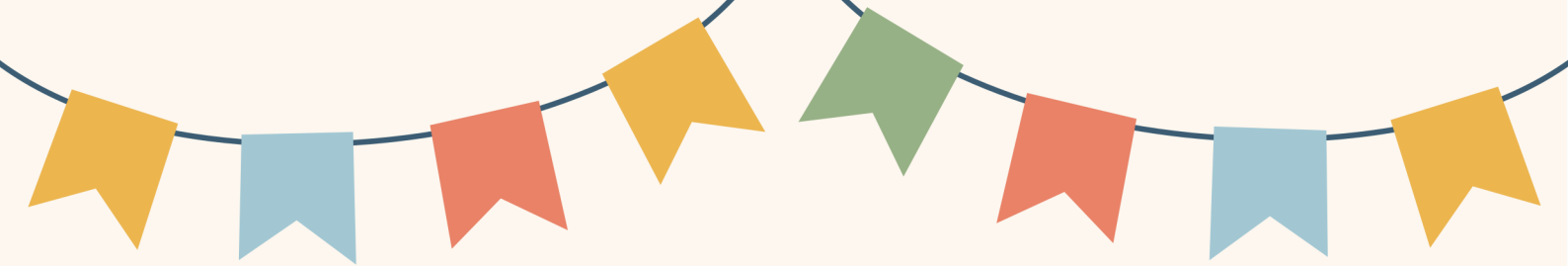

Quick Guide



What is parentsportal.scot?

Parentsportal.scot is a digital service to help replace the traditional school bag run by providing direct communication to parents and carers through a selection of online services.

Who can use parentsportal.scot?

Access to parentsportal.scot is only for those parents or carers who have children in Primary 1 through to the final year of secondary and are already confirmed as a contact for that child.

If your children is about to start at a North Lanarkshire school or your children will be starting in P1 or S1 from August, your school will inform you during their first term when you can set up your account.

What will you see?

- annual data check
- online payments
- parent evening appointments
- permission slips
- reporting absence
- viewing timetables (secondary schools)
- pupil reports

How do you sign up?

Access to parentsportal.scot is through myaccount, a service which allows you to access a range of Scottish public services online using one username and password. It also makes it a one-stop-shop for digital services available in North Lanarkshire.

Scan here to register or sign into myaccount.



Once you have registered for a myaccount, and agreed to the conditions, you will be able to use the same login details to sign in to parentsportal.scot.

You will then need to link your children to your parentsportal.scot account.

To do this simply follow the steps shown in this video guide.
