School Flu Immunisation programme 2020

As you may have seen in the media, all children have to be offered the flu vaccine. School Nursing teams will be in school on Wednesday 9th December to immunise all pupils. Most consent forms have been returned in their brown envelopes.

Is your child due to start school in August 2021?

Your child must have attained the age of 5 years between 1 March 2021 and 28 February 2021.

To register you should now complete an "Online" application and submit no later than 6 November 2020.

Breakfast Club/Lunches

Free school meals include all Primary 1-4 pupils. For Primary 5-7 pupils the cost of lunch is still £1.90. At present the school is not taking monetary payments. There is a new BACS system in place and payments are made on a weekly/monthly basis through your bank. Should you require more details regarding BACS payments please phone the school office. Breakfast club is following the same process of BACS. Breakfast club also costs £1.90 per day. With siblings there is a discount.

Wet Mornings

Scottish Government guidance tells us that our children should be out in all weathers. On occasions of **extremely** wet mornings, pupils are welcomed into the school when they arrive from 8.45am onwards. Pupils should enter through the doors in the playground and not via the main entrance.

Outdoor Learning & PE -

Unfortunately this advice remains unchanged

In line with advice from the Scottish Government, children will be outside for playtime and lunchtime every day. Can we ask that you send your child to school with a waterproof jacket please?

Children will require **waterproof jackets** for Outdoor Learning, which is timetabled once a week.

All **PE lessons will** take place outside, in all weathers. PE will take place once a week this term. Full PE kit is not required for the moment, however if you would like to send your child to school PE kit under uniform this will be permitted. Children are required to bring a change of shoes for PE if possible please.

Covid Symptoms

The symptoms are the onset of a **persistent cough**, or **a temperature/fever** or a **loss of taste or smell**. You only need one of these to be tested. This can be done by calling 0800 028 2816 or visiting the NHS Inform website – <u>www.nhsinform.scot</u>. You do not need to call NHS 24 to organise a test. If you require further advice **contact your GP**.
