Literacy



This term we will be learning initial sounds of the alphabet and will begin to blend these letters to make three letter words e.g. sat, pin. Children are encouraged to regularly revise these sounds at home (Spotting the sounds in a story for example). Activities on Seesaw for weekly homework will help Children to revise each sound.

Children will listen to stories being read in the class and explore both fiction and non fiction picture books. We will discuss the characters in a book, share our opinions on a story. The children will learn to point out the title of a book as well as learn about the jobs of the author and illustrator.

The children will be able to orally state a sentence to match the picture for the teacher to scribe. This will be their first step in learning to write. They will be practising their formation of letters and numbers also.

Numeracy

Pupils will be learning;

- To recognise, count and write numbers to 10.
- To identify the number before, after and between up to 10.
- To talk about time and events e.g. days, months, seasons.
- To use our class calendar and timetable.
- To identify and continue short shape, colour and number patterns.

Health and Wellbeing

This term we will be focussing on Emotional Wellbeing. We will learn about feelings, how to talk about how we feel and also about the importance of friendship.

In P.E we will be developing our ability to work with others when playing games. PE is an opportunity for children to develop their communication and cooperation skills through games.

Topic - People Who Help Us


