

## LITERACY

The children will be reading their school reading books daily with an adult. As well as this the children will be listening to the teacher read out different stories such as Treasure Island. The children will also be given the opportunity to select a personal reading book that they can keep within their trays and they will be allocated ERIC (Everyone Reading In Class) time throughout the day.

We will be using active spelling approaches to introduce new vocabulary and sounds throughout the term both within our spelling groups and reinforce with multi sensory activities. In addition to this, to improve our spelling, we will continue to work on our cursive handwriting by completing our double joins weekly.

We will continue to develop our listening and talking skills through our co-operative class discussions. The children will have the opportunity to work with a partner to complete activities. They will be encouraged to take the role of the teacher and present their information and facts with confidence and enthusiasm.

## NUMERACY

This term the children will develop their skills when:-

- applying addition and subtraction when solving problems, making best use of the mental and written strategies developed
- using various strategies including arrays, groupings subtraction to multiply and divide
- understanding the relationship between  $\times$  and  $\div$  and use this to solve word problems



## HEALTH AND WELLBEING

This term the children will identify strategies to help them cope with difficult situations and understand that feelings and reactions can change depending upon what is happening within and around their environment. They will be developing their skills on their communication and co-ordination through team games. As well as this the children will be focusing on our St Blanes values and they will be creating their very own "Value Characters" that will show others how to demonstrate this value throughout the school.



## Social Subjects

### Community

This term the children will be focusing on their community and how this is built up from several different aspects of their life. This will be their home life, school life and any other wider community involvement such as the church. The children will be discussing what makes a community and how they feel about their own one. As well as this we will be focussing on how the children can improve their community through their actions and how they treat one another.



## RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

This term the children will continue to learn about the Gospel messages and how they can apply this to their lives.
