We advise that you complete this book with your child and read it as many times as your child wishes before they start school.


We look forward to a fantastic new session in August.

In August you will be starting school at St. Francis Primary. In the morning your family will wake you up and give you your breakfast. Once you have had your breakfast you will put on your new school uniform.





You will feel happy in your new classroom. Your Teacher will show you where to hang up your jacket. You will have your own hook with your name on it.




Write your child's name below
