## Children who are Unwell

We always ask parents and carers to keep children at home if they are unwell and for 48 hours if they have sickness or diarrhea. We will all have to be extra vigilant and respond quickly if we see that a child is unwell when they are with us or with you at home and be extra vigilant to the symptoms of COVID:

- 🌡️ Fever/high temperature
- 👃 New continuous cough
- 👅 Loss of or change in sense of taste or smell

Just to be clear, in the event that a child displays any of the above symptoms, **they should not be attending and we would expect the family to follow the appropriate Test and Protect guidance.** Where a child displays symptoms in nursery or school, their parent/carer will be contacted immediately and asked to come and collect their child. On being collected, you will be advised to follow the Test and Protect guidance and self-isolation. Our school and nursery has a room identified within our risk assessment where children can isolate while waiting to be collected with appropriate measures in place.
