Fluoride Varnishing

The Childsmile Nursery and School team from NHS GG&C will be visiting on the **15th**, **16th** and **17th** of **September** to apply Fluoride Varnish to the children's teeth.

Consent forms will be issued shortly to our Nursery – P4 children and must be returned. If you do not give consent, the Childsmile team will not be able to apply the fluoride varnish to your child's teeth.

We would also like to update you on homework arrangements for this term. All classes will officially begin homework week beginning 1st September. Homework tasks will be uploaded to Showbie, and jotters will be sent home for your child to complete the tasks.

Thank you for your continued support in helping your child build a positive and productive homework routine.

Pick up and drop off

Just a gentle reminder: there is no adult supervision in our playground until 8:50 AM. Now that the children are familiar with their lineup locations, we kindly ask that adults refrain from entering the playground, except for families accessing the nursery. Starting this week, all Primary 1 children should arrive at school by 9:00 AM. P7 buddies and senior leaders will meet them at the entrance and walk them to their playground. Primary 1 and Primary 2 will be dismissed from the side gate, while Primary 3 through Primary 7 will exit from the front gate. During the first few weeks, our P1 and P2 staff will be at the side gate from around 2:50 PM to help everyone adjust to the routine. We kindly ask that you avoid blocking the exit, as it can be overwhelming for the children.

Lost Property

Please remind your children to collect any forgotten items, such as clothing or lunch boxes, from the lost property area, as staff may not be able to assist at the end of the day. Labelling items with names greatly helps in returning them to their owners.

Medication, data check and photo permission

If your child requires medication during school hours and has a medical care plan, Miss Lynch will be in touch over the next two weeks to ensure the information is up to date. If you are new to the school and need a medical care plan, please contact the school to arrange a meeting. Primary 1 pupils will also receive a data check form and a photo permission form. Please be sure to check their school bags, as these forms require parental signatures.


PE Dates

A gentle reminder that our PE kit consists of a yellow polo shirt and black shorts or joggers. Children should come to school wearing their PE kit on the days listed below


