

ANTI BULLYING CHARTER



1. All children and young people have human rights. Bullying is a breach of Children's Rights and children need to be protected from bullying behaviour.
2. Bullying behaviour is never acceptable.
3. Bullying behaviour needs to be challenged and effectively addressed.
4. Adults have an important role to play.
5. Bullying behaviour will not be tolerated; this helps to create an environment where bullying behaviour is less likely to thrive.
6. Children have the right to protection from all forms of physical or mental violence, injury or abuse.

- Deal with the bullying behaviour



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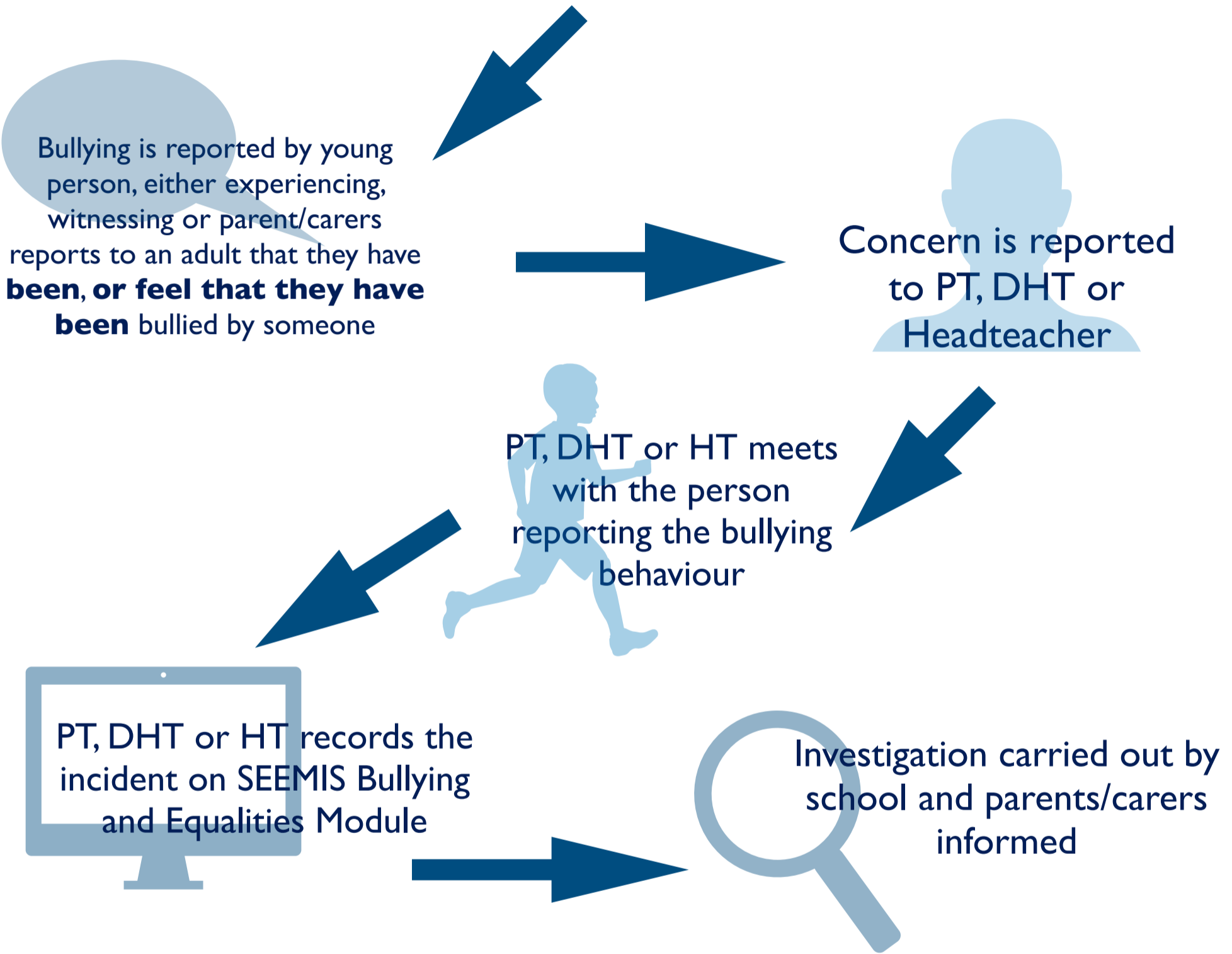
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BULLYING RESPONSE PROCESS



<p>Evidence that Bullying took place</p> <p>Action taken to support young person experiencing bullying and also young person displaying bullying behaviour, SEEMIS updated.</p>	<p>No evidence that Bullying took place</p> <p>School responds to original concern, explaining outcome of investigation. Further action may be required to resolve any further concerns. SEEMIS module updated to record that incident was unfounded.</p>
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
